You are a U.S. citizen if you have a: Birth certificate showing birth in the United States; Form N-550, Certificate of Naturalization; Form N-560, Certificate of Citizenship; Form FS-240, Report of Birth Abroad of United States Citizen; or Valid unexpired U.S. passport.

Proof of Citizenship for U.S. Citizens | USCIS

Apply for U.S. citizenship by submitting Form N-400, Application for Naturalization. This form is available to file online. There are exceptions and modifications to the naturalization requirements that are available to those who qualify. USCIS also provides accommodations for individuals with disabilities. Naturalization is the process to become a U.S. citizen if you were born outside of the United States. If you meet certain requirements, you may become a U.S. citizen either at birth or after birth.

Become a U.S. Citizen Through Naturalization | USCIS

Between 27 September 1906 and 31 March 1956, the Federal Naturalization Service filed these copies together in packets known as C-Files. Information that you might expect to find in post-1906 U.S. C-Files includes: Prior to 1906, any "court of record"—municipal, county, district, state, or Federal court—could grant U.S. citizenship.

How to Get Copies of US Naturalization and Citizenship Records

Submit your original evidence of U.S. citizenship. Submit a photocopy of the front (and back, if there is printed information) of your original evidence of U.S. citizenship. Photocopies must be: legible, on white 8.5"x11" standard paper, black and white, and single sided.

To ensure a successful request with the National Archives researchers should include: name of petitioner (including known variants); date of birth; approximate date of entry to the US; approximate date of naturalization; where the individual was residing at the time of naturalization ...

You are a U.S. citizen if: You have a birth certificate issued by a U.S. state. You were born in a U.S. territory and have a birth certificate issued by that territory. If you don't have a birth certificate from your birth territory, you may be able to verify your citizenship status using other documents.

You are not a U.S. citizen until you take the Oath of Allegiance at a naturalization ceremony. What to do: Complete the questionnaire on Form N-445, Notice of Naturalization Oath Ceremony. Report for your naturalization ceremony and check in with USCIS. A USCIS officer will review your responses to Form N-445.

As part of the naturalization process, all U.S. citizenship applicants are required to provide supporting documents to U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS). Which documents are necessary depends on each applicant's situation.

Documents Needed for the Citizenship Application and Interview

Proof of Citizenship **Y** ou must provide proof of citizenship for all US passport services. Most passport applicants are able to submit preferred evidence of United States citizenship for passport requests, such as a birth certificate showing birth in the United States or a previously-issued US passport.

Form N-565 Replacement of Citizenship Certificate On approval of their application for citizenship by the USCIS, US citizens will be issued a citizenship certificate. If your citizenship certificate is lost or stolen, you can get a replacement of the same by filing Form N-565 with the USCIS.

In the United States, the citizenship process has a lot of requirements and starts with the citizenship application (USCIS Form N-400) and culminates with the naturalization ceremony, after which you are officially considered an American.

The naturalization application fee is \$725 (including the \$85 biometric services fee). The U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services offers a fee waiver program and a reduced fee option to applicants who meet certain requirements. A. THE IMMIGRATION & NATIONALITY ACT. Section 349(a)(5) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA) (8 U.S.C. 1481(a)(5)) is the section of law governing the right of a United States citizen to renounce abroad his or her U.S. citizenship. That section of law provides for the loss of nationality by voluntarily and with the intention of relinquishing nationality:
