Your civil documents MUST be issued by the official issuing authority in your country. Please refer to the Document Finder to learn about the civil document requirements for each country.

Civil Documents - Travel

Civil documents must bear an original signature, stamp, and seal of the issuing office or registrar. Copies certified by attorneys, Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, etc., are not acceptable. For any document not in English or in the official language of the country from which you are applying, a notarized translation is required in addition to the original.

Civil Documents for USA Immigrant Visa - Consular Processing

Immigrant visa applicants are required to submit certain civil documents as part of their visa application, such as birth certificates and police records. (Nonimmigrant visa applicants do not routinely need to submit civil documents as part of their visa application.)

U.S. Visa: Reciprocity and Civil Documents by Country

Civil Documents Immigrant Visa Application

If applying for an immigrant visa through a U.S. consulate abroad, applicants must send photocopies of all required civil documents to the National Visa Center, and, in addition, must submit the originals, or certified copies, and a photocopy of each required civil document to the U.S. Embassy or Consulate at the time of your interview.

Civil Documents Required for Visa Processing - Sivaraman ...

The final set of documents each family member who is immigrating will likely be required to prepare and bring to the interview at the U.S. consulate includes: Two color photographs, passport style. Current, original passports for everyone in family who is getting an immigrant visa (they must not expire earlier than six months after interview date).

Forms and Documents Needed for a Family Immigrant Visa at ...

Petitioner: A U.S. citizen or lawful permanent resident family member or employer (or the employer's agent) who files a family-based or employment-based immigrant visa petition with USCIS. Applicant: A foreign citizen who is applying for a nonimmigrant or immigrant U.S. visa. The visa applicant may also be referred as a beneficiary for petition ...

Scan Documents - Travel

To submit documents, log into CEAC and go to the "Start Now" buttons located under Affidavit of Support Documents and Civil Documents. When you have uploaded all the required documents for each section, press "Submit Documents". The "Submit Documents" buttons will not work unless you have uploaded all of the required documents for each person. Once you press "Submit Documents", your case will be placed in line for review at the National Visa Center (NVC).

Submit Documents - Travel

The visa application is not formally made until the visa applicant (s) is interviewed by a U.S. consular officer. After submitting Form DS-260 online, you must print the confirmation page and bring it to your interview. You can print this from CEAC any time after you complete your DS-260 application. Online Application - Travel

If your application is being processed by the Immigrant Visa Unit at the Embassy, you are required to obtain the original or certified copy, and one photocopy (with the exception of your passport and photographs) of the following documents for yourself and each family member applying for a visa. All documents are required even if they were previously submitted to the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services with your petition.

Required Documents for Family Immigration Visas

Completed Form DS-260 (Online Immigrant Visa Application) at <http://ceac.state.gov/ceac/>. Scanned and uploaded civil documents, affidavit of support forms, financial documents of the petitioner and sponsor/s into the CEAC portal using a login. Scanned documents must not exceed the 4MB size limit.

Visa Update: Preparing For Your Immigrant Visa Interview ...

Visas will not be approved until applicants submit all required documents. All applicants for immigrant or fiancé(e) visas must pay the appropriate application fee. The fees charged depend on the type of visa. Please see Fees for Visa Services for a complete list of fees. Applicants who have paid the immigrant fees to NVC are not required to ...
