They often prescribed this order to students, not because it was absolutely ideal, but because using the scheme encouraged the writer to take ...

The Classical Argument

The classical argument is made up of five components, which are most commonly composed in the following order: Exordium - The introduction, opening, or hook. Narratio - The context or background of the topic. Propositio and Partitio - The claim/stance and the argument.

A Classical argument is the basic form of persuasive argument typically used in essays and position papers. It has at least five parts: the introduction, narration, confirmation, refutation, and conclusion. The parts of a classical argument are arranged logically. That is, one section logically follows from the one before it.

Here is the basic outline of a classical argument paper: Introduction: Get readers interest and attention, state the problem, and explain why they should care. Background: Provide some context and key facts surrounding the problem. Thesis: State your position or claim and outline your main arguments.

The first argument is based entirely on feelings, whereas the second is based on evidence that can be proven. The standard five paragraph format is common, but not required, for argumentative essays. These essays typically follow one of two formats: the Toulmin model or the Rogerian model. The Toulmin model is the most common.

The classical model argumentative essay takes into account the following things: Introduces the main claim or the argument of the essay. Present the writer's perspective on the argument. The reasons something is not working and why something should be done. Take into account the other side of the argument.
